



Past International President Walter C. Fisher Passes Away

Past International President Walter C. Fisher, of St. Catharines, Ontario, Canada, passed away January 20, 1988. Funeral services were private.

Past International President Fisher was a Life Member of the St. Catharines (Central) Lions Club which he joined in 1933. He served as District Governor in 1943-44, as an International Director in 1945-46 and as International President in 1949-50. He also served as an appointee to various committees of the International Board of Directors from 1961 to 1974.

His dedicated work on behalf of Lionism earned him 15 International President's Awards and the Ambassador of Goodwill Award.

Past International President Fisher was involved for many years in the sales and real estate fields. In addition to his activities as a Lion, he donated his time and efforts in support of numerous community programs, including his school board, the Niagara Peninsula Sanatorium and the St. Catharines General Hospital.

He is survived by his wife, Alice; two daughters, Mrs. Bryan (Cathie) Gilbert and Mrs. David (Carolyn) List and one son, Walter, Jr.
